

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY

BY APPLYING FOR, ACCEPTING AFTER ISSUE, OR USING A LAWTRUST CERTIFICATE YOU, THE SUBSCRIBER, AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Law Trusted Third Party Services (Pty) Ltd ("LAWtrust") is a provider of accreditation products and services, which includes providing digital certificates digitally signed by LAWtrust in its capacity as a certification authority ("LAWtrust2048 CA") which contain the subscriber's public key.
- 1.2 The LAWtrust digital certificate contains information provided by you, the subscriber, which is authenticated and verified by a LAWtrust Registration Authority, in this instance LT-RA, in terms of the LAWtrust Certification Practice Statement (CPS), available at <https://www.lawtrust.co.za/repository>, and the LAWtrust RA Charter, available at <https://www.lawtrust.co.za/repository>.
- 1.3 This Subscriber Agreement governs your application for, acceptance of and use of a LAWtrust digital certificate.

2. LAWTRUST CPS AND LAWTRUST RA CHARTER

- 2.1 The provisions of the LAWtrust CPS and the RA Charter govern the practice of the LAWtrust2048 CA in issuing a LAWtrust digital certificate and the LT-RA in authenticating and verifying the information provided by you, the subscriber, in applying for a LAWtrust digital certificate.
- 2.2 The provisions of the LAWtrust CPS and the RA Charter under which this application is made, are acknowledged by you, the subscriber, to be binding on you in applying for, accepting the issue of and using the LAWtrust digital certificate.
- 2.3 The disclaimers of warranties, limitations of liability and general administrative provisions of the LAWtrust CPS are incorporated into this Subscribers Agreement by reference and are binding on LAWtrust, LT-RA and the subscriber.

3. CERTIFICATE APPLICATION

3.1 The subscriber shall complete an application form diligently and accurately and provide all information required on the LAWtrust Certificate Application Form to the LT-RA.

3.2 The subscriber shall, within a reasonable time be advised of the grant or rejection of the application by e-mail addressed to the e-mail address provided in the application.

4. SUBSCRIBER'S OBLIGATION

- 4.1 The subscriber shall:
 - 4.1.1 in making the application, satisfy him/herself that the LAWtrust digital certificate applied for is satisfactory for the purpose for which the subscriber intends to use it;
 - 4.1.2 comply with the terms of the LAWtrust CPS and the RA Charter;
 - 4.1.3 generate a key-pair using a trusted cryptographic service provider;
 - 4.1.4 be responsible for the management of the private key associated with the LAWtrust digital certificate;
 - 4.1.5 protect the confidentiality of the private key as well as any pass-phrase or token used to activate the private key;
 - 4.1.6 not use the LAWtrust digital certificate for any unlawful purposes;
 - 4.1.7 on receipt of the LAWtrust digital certificate check that the information contained in the LAWtrust digital certificate is accurate;
 - 4.1.8 promptly request the LT-RA to revoke the LAWtrust digital certificate immediately on becoming aware of any inaccuracy in the LAWtrust digital certificate or suspected loss, disclosure or compromise of the private key held by the subscriber;

4.1.9 not use the LAWtrust digital certificate issued to him/her as a certification authority issuing further certificates, certificate revocation or otherwise;

4.1.10 not monitor, interfere with, or reverse-engineer any technical implementation required for the creation of a LAWtrust digital certificate, or its use, or otherwise in any manner intentionally compromise the security provided by LAWtrust.

4.2 The subscriber acknowledges that any failure to comply with its obligations in terms of 4.1 shall constitute a material breach of this Subscribers Agreement.

4.3 The subscriber further acknowledges the potential risk of a compromise of the subscriber and/or another subscriber's private key, which may or may not be detected, and the potential risk of a stolen or compromised private key being used to forge the subscriber or another subscriber's digital signature.

5. LAWTRUST SERVICES

5.1 The LAWtrust2048 CA shall appoint the LT-RA which shall conduct itself in accordance with the LAWtrust CPS and the RA Charter approved by the LAWtrust Policy Authority (LAWtrust PA).

5.2 The LAWtrust2048 CA shall only issue a LAWtrust digital certificate against receipt from the LT-RA of a Certificate Signing Request.

5.3 The LAWtrust2048 CA shall conduct its certification practice in accordance with the provisions of the LAWtrust CPS.

6. COMMENCEMENT AND DURATION

6.1 This agreement shall commence on the date that a subscriber submits a digital certificate application to the RA.

6.2 This agreement shall terminate on:

6.2.1 the rejection of the LAWtrust digital certificate application;

6.2.2 the revocation of the LAWtrust digital certificate;

6.2.3 immediately on the LAWtrust digital certificate's stated validity period expiring;

6.2.4 on the date indicated in a notice addressed by the LT-RA to the subscriber terminating this agreement.
