APPOINTMENT OF LAW TRUST THIRD PARTY (PROPRIETARY) LIMITED AS AN ACCREDITED AUTHENTICATION PRODUCTS AND SERVICES PROVIDERS IN TERMS OF THE ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AND TRANSACTIONS ACT OF 2002 (ECT ACT)

The ECT Act provides for authentication products and services providers to apply to the South African Accreditation Authority (SAAA) in the Department of Communications for accreditation. The accreditation of authentication products and services allows the electronic signatures of such products and services to qualify as advanced electronic signatures. On the 16 September 2011, Law Trust Third Party (Proprietary) Limited ("LawTrust") submitted the first South African application for accreditation.

In accordance with the requirements of the ECT Act regulations on accreditation, evaluators (Dm5 Commercial Attorneys) were appointed to evaluate Law Trust application. The evaluation process has been completed, and the final report on the findings was submitted to the Department.
